#### From Mr Jolliffe

Thank you for your patience last Friday when some of the federation schools were closed due to the bad weather. It is always a really hard decision to make as the great British weather is so variable and whilst there was heavy snow at Cheriton Fitzpaine, there was hardly any at Thorverton. In principle we will always try to keep the schools open and expect children who can walk to school to do so. Children who take a day off when they could be in school will be recorded as having an 'unauthorised absence' and this could lead to further action by Devon County Council. I know many families made a huge effort to get to school in the bad weather and this was appreciated by everyone; thank you! If there is a spell of bad weather again, we will try to let parents know what is happening as soon as possible, once we are reasonably sure that what is forecast is actually happening. The full governing board met at Newton St Cyres School on Tuesday, 5<sup>th</sup> February. Items on the agenda included reviewing the Head of Schools' reports for this term, an update on the Management Partnership with Silverton, a recap on discussions at recent Resources and School Improvement Committee meetings and looking ahead to upcoming governor events.

We hope you have all now received and read the consultation document about the proposal to change the age range at Brampford Speke, Cheriton Fitzpaine and Newton St Cyres to include two year olds. There is still time to respond by email if you wish to do so. Alternatively, please attend the consultation meetings which are taking place on Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> February or Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> February.

You should also have now received this year's parent questionnaire. Please do respond (by Friday, 15<sup>th</sup>) as governors really do value your views, and your responses enable us to shape the future direction of the federation. This year there are additional questions on the breadth of the curriculum offered at our schools and the impact that this has on your child. This is an area that governors are particularly interested in at the moment, and they will be carrying out a Governor Learning Walk with this as a focus after half term. In addition to the questionnaire, we will be holding School Reviews in March to follow up any points raised.

Mr Jolliffe updated governors on the Management Partnership with Silverton. He explained that he had been working closely with Mrs Adnams, Headteacher at Silverton, who has also been involved in the weekly leadership meetings and recent leadership day. In addition, teachers from the Exe Valley Federation have had the opportunity to work alongside colleagues from Silverton sharing good practice and expertise. Mr Nichols shared the plan for the 'Great Outdoor Day' next half term, where our pupils will join Silverton for an exciting day of outdoor learning activities, including singing by the campfire, following treasure maps and art!
